Be careful when you mow!

If you disturb a bunny nest, please cover it back up!
Place twigs in an X over the nest and check the next morning.



What if you do uncover a nest?

Wild bunny nests are very shallow and easily uncovered.

Unless babies are injured, just re-cover the nest. Mom will return to feed as long as the nest is not moved. But only at dawn and dusk, so don't worry if you don't see her. She tries hard NOT to be seen.

If the baby truly needs rehabilitation or you have questions about your specific situation, contact a licensed wildlife rehabilitator who can legally and properly help the baby.
